### Transportation:

Please make your school bus reservation with the District or approved charter bus company. Ensure that students are lined up outside and ready to be picked up at the times below. Buses use Field Trip Entrance and stop near Educational Gate.

**School Pick Up:** 8:45a

**Departure from Park:** 1:30p

**Date:** March – May on Thursday or Friday. Please email [info@oceanconnectors.org](mailto:info@oceanconnectors.org) to confirm your specific field trip date.

**Bring Student Lunches?** Yes. Students will eat lunch in the picnic area inside the park between 12:00-12:30p. Lunches are stored in yellow cabinets.

**Parent Chaperones:** Required 1 adult chaperone per group of 10 students. Chaperones should arrive on the school bus with the class (recommended), or obtain a chaperone parking placard if driving separately. All chaperones must submit the required District paperwork in advance.

**Rain-or-Shine Trip?** Yes. The park has various indoor spaces and exhibits, so this trip will NOT be canceled in the event of mild rain. Students should wear comfortable, closed-toed shoes and sunscreen, and dress in warm layers.

### Special Notes:

- **Signed liability and appearance release forms must be submitted at the start of the field trip for every student and parent chaperone in attendance. Students who attend without the signed forms will need to be picked up by their parent or guardian to immediately return to school.**
- If possible, please have students wear their school t-shirt or sweatshirt.
- If students have a SeaWorld pass/fun card, please ask them to bring their card on the trip.
- Please complete the SeaWorld Participant Count Sheet in advance to expedite check-in.
- **Students may not go on rides and are not permitted in the Bay of Play area. As time is limited, please avoid spending time in gift shops/restaurants.**
- Students **must stay in their group with the assigned chaperone** at all times, and must follow directions provided by Ocean Connectors and park staff.
- This is an educational field trip – **students should be engaged in learning by reading educational signs, taking notes, and asking questions throughout the trip.**
